Princess Adjoba Nyaniba Yankson Joh sat for her West African Basic Education (WAEC) having agregate of best six distinctions in Burma Camp (Ghana). After that, she was enrolled in Tema Senior Secondary School (TEMASCO) as a Science student; Coming out with an outstanding grade. During her years in school, she got involved in various social activities.

As years went by, based on her good results, Princess Nyaniba was enrolled in West African Insurance Institute (WAII) in the Gambia as a private student; a course for prospective middle managers in insurance and risks Management where she obtained a Diploma certificate in Insurance and Risks Management.

Later on, Princess Nyaniba attended Management Development Institute (MDI) in the Gambia, where she obtained a distinctive diploma in Management Studies. She then began her professional career working with Gamstar Insurance Company and after for Great Alliance Insurance Company in the Gambia for a period of 8 years. During her working period in the Insurance industry, Princess Nyaniba participated in various insurance seminars and workshops organized by Mainstream Re (Accra-Ghana), Continental Re (Lagos Nigeria) etc.

She is hard working, very determined, very ambitious at work and good in what she does. Due to this reason, she was promoted from being an underwriter to an Officer in the Insurance Company heading the reinsurance department, which is the back bone of every insurance company. In addition, she was honored and given a certificate of Merit in recognition of satisfactory performance of duty. But despite her outstanding performance towards her professional career, she had a great passion for the Art in general, and crocheting in particular

Her weaving skills began through her childhood days as a hobby but as years went by, she became more creative than ever that she started to make "ends meat" from it. But Princess Nyaniba felt it was not enough so she travelled to England to look for a Designer who could help her to explore more in the Art. After months of search for the Designer, it wasn't successful and she returned to the Gambia. However, she didn't sit but kept working towards her vision and goals. She registered her own Art business called ADJOBA DESIGNS in 2010.

She wanted to enlarge her Art gallery, so she joined and became a member of ASSET (Association of Small Scale Entreprises in Tourism) but was still not satisfied by the impact of her Art. She began having various interviews with the gambian medias and magazines in order to find designers to upgrade her Art but all was in vain.

One day at a social meeting in the Gambia, she came across the Cultural Heritage and Peace Emperor H. Malatsi SIWA from South Africa. Convinced by his expertise, she decided to give a full attention to the Art. Deep down in her, she knew it was a calling and that was her destiny. The strong desire and passion she had for the Art was unexplainable. She then began the Art lessons with His Majesty Siwa from scramble Art, painting, decoration, dance, singing, poetry, nutrition etc. The teachings with him were not only about the Art but also about life after the Art; always saying that it is good to be versatile cause we never know how the future is going to be. From 2010 till today, Princess Nyaniba has been travelling with His Majesty Siwa across Africa (Gambia, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Mali, Burkina Faso, Guinea Conakry, Morocco, Ghana ...) as an incubator and member of THE MESSENGERS OF MESSAGES (MOMS), a Panafrikan Cultural and Artistic Edutainment Movement they have created in 2010 and formalized officially as an NGO in 2020 with other members from various African countries. Being part of the MOMS allowed her to make her cereer international, realise how blessed her Continent is, but also to know the major probems affecting it and contribute in finding the solutions to solve them through the Arts. She was then able to change the lives of many underprivileged youth. women, people living with disabilities, migrants etc. using Art, Culture and words of wisdom as weapons. She was able to meet and receive awards from Presidents, Kings, various dignitaries and international organizations based on their actions as MESSENGERS OF MESSAGES.



Princess Nyaniba mainly intervention 5 different fields such as:


- Poetry: She writes and performs on different occasions poems about Africa, Culture, women and different topics affecting Africa and the world.
